Coxwell Hall has been decorated in a manner that reflects the elegance of the building and its listed status. It is tasteful and of a standard you would expect of such a glorious building.

The accommodation has been specifically designed to care for our elderly residents suffering from memory loss conditions.

The Hall is built over two floors and each has a dining room and lounge which are easily accessible by lift and provide areas of companionship and stimulation.

Our experienced chef uses fresh produce to offer a daily menu choice to appeal to even the most select of appetites and not only is the food well balanced in a dietary sense but it also caters to the residents personal requirements and choices.

At Coxwell Hall we endeavour to offer our residents a real home from home experience that affords them privacy, dignity and choice in their daily lives.

What can we offer you

We encourage our residents to be as independent, active and involved as they wish to be, whilst always respecting their wishes should they feel like a little quiet time.

The spacious lounge areas are the perfect setting to watch television, listen to music or simply have a chat.

Should a resident choose to be alone, our light and airy conservatories, which face onto the secluded gardens, can offer the peace and serenity that many of us would love to experience; whatever they choose, the most important issue is that they have a choice.

Our fully equipped sensory room also provides a calm oasis for residents to relax in at any time.

Our Activities Co-ordinators encourage the pursuit of hobbies and interests whilst inviting outside volunteers to visit and help with the organisation of activities and social events throughout the year.

One to one activities are promoted by all staff but our comprehensive programme of social gatherings includes outings, guest speakers and entertainers to come along and give our residents a generally good time! Something for everyone is on the agenda whilst taking into account all faiths and religious preferences.

We do not restrict visiting at all during the day which makes contact with family so much more flexible and possible to manage for all involved. At Coxwell Hall we never forget the resident but as importantly, we know that their families have busy lives to juggle as well!

Here at Coxwell Hall we don't just care for the resident; we care for the family too!



A home from home environment

All the bedrooms at Coxwell Hall have en-suite facilities, many of which have the luxury of a view over the beautiful gardens.

The majority are single rooms but all of them are equipped with a Nurse Call System which offers complete peace of mind, whether it is day or night, for both resident and family members alike. This facility also extends to all communal areas throughout the home.

We also have the facility to provide accommodation for people who wish or need to share a room, such as married couples or siblings.

Residents are encouraged to bring small personal items and items of furniture with them as often it is the smallest things that make the biggest difference.

Our aim is to make the transition from their home to Coxwell Hall as smooth and effortless as possible enabling them to settle in that much quicker and achieve their sense of belonging.

The Home is well equipped with assisted bathing and showering facilities to ensure each resident can enjoy the personal hygiene of their choice.

Coxwell Hall provides a secure environment for residents to walk around freely, including the garden area.



Dedicated to your care

Lead by our highly qualified and experienced Nursing Manager, all the staff at Coxwell Hall are dedicated to provide the kind of care we would all like to receive in our twilight years. Care which includes privacy and dignity whilst maintaining the balance of each residents individual needs. Registered Mental Health Nurses provide specialist leadership for the care of our residents with memory loss conditions.

We have two local General Practitioner Practices that are delighted to be associated with us and therefore all of our residents are registered with them. The doctors visit on a weekly basis to care and provide for the residents as requested by our Nurse and in emergency situations.

Registered nurses are on duty 24 hours a day together with trained NVQ Level 2 and 3 Care Assistants. All of our staff receive continuous education and development to ensure our residents receive the best possible care.

We are extremely proud that many of our staff at Coxwell Hall have worked here for between 5 and 10 years, an indication of the kind of environment what we are promoting. We do not employ agency staff, therefore everyone who works here knows the residents and each other very well.

We aim to provide an atmosphere that is calm and conducive to the care of the elderly in their daily lives.



A personal service

Here at Coxwell Hall we practice 'person centred care' to ensure that the individuality and character of our residents is valued and preserved. It is important that they feel Coxwell Hall is their home where their independence can shine and they can be themselves.

The support network however, also extends to the residents having access to the external services of a chiropodist, dentist, optician, physiotherapist, speech therapist and audiologist.

These are all qualified practitioners who visit us on a regular basis and who we know and trust.

We treat your family like our family and at Coxwell Hall you can rest assured that we are caring for them exactly as you would.
